Who is eligible?

Family must:

Reside in Majestic Oaks, Tower Oaks/Tower Oaks Glen, Linton Oaks, Holly Heights, Harbor Cove, Pine Meadow Gordon Manor or Hidden Oak MHP.*

*Must provide photo ID and utility bill to verify address.

OR

Be a veteran, the location of residences does not matter as long as it is in Alachua County.*

*Must provide VA ID and, if not included, photo ID.



Pick-up

Pickup will be by appointment only on November 23rd and 24th.

Note: If you have a disability or are bedridden, SWAG will bring the basket to your home. Food that is NOT picked up on time will be given to a patron on the waiting list.

REMEMBER: Bring your photo ID when picking up your basket.
